Make your own halloween costume

Materials

1. Cape, made by the Fikserij, one size fits all
2. Felt, in different colours
3. Templates, made by the fixerij out of wood: things like ghosts or a superman logo, the alphabet
4. Textile markers

Instructions

1. Choose a piece of felt in the colour of your liking
2. Choose a template that you like
3. Put the template on the felt
4. Go around the template with a textile marker
5. Cut the felt on the line that you have just drawn
6. Sew the felt onto the cape in a spot you like (explain how to thread a needle, sew, make the beginning and end knots, etc.)
7. Repeat these steps, but this time, use the alphabet template to make your name
8. Use the textile markers to make extra drawings on your cape
9. You can also sew other pieces of felt on your cape by using your own imagination, transform your cape into the cape of a superhero, a wizard, a princes or anything else you want
10. Wear your cape on halloween

Learning objectives

1. You can use the sewing skills you just learned the next time a button pops of your shirt
2. Express your interests through your outfits and clothing style
3. Think about shapes, colours and organisation

1. Zine papers, pre-cut by the Fikserij
2. Stickers
3. Red mica

Instructions

1. Fold the zine
2. Design the cover
3. Leaf your mark by collecting leafs and using them as stamps
4. Draw your happy moments
5. Draw objects using leafs you found as a guide

2. express thoughts, memories and feelings through drawing and decorating
3. reflect on happy moments, favorite seasons or meaningful memories
4. Think about shapes, colours and what things remind you of.

Make a holiday box filled with surprises

Materials

1. Christmas ornament, made by the fikserij out of wood
2. Markers
3. Trangular card, make out of thick cardboard by the fikserij
4. green wool
5. cotton balls
6. stickers: holiday themed and the alphabet
7. glue
8. Ribbons

Instructions

Make your own ornament

1. Use the markers to decorate the ornament, in the video's you can see easy tutorials on how to draw a christmas tree or a snowman
2. Use your own imagination to draw anything you want on the ornament
3. Hang the ornament in your christas tree or on the knob of a window
4. Design your own holiday card
5. Cut a piece of wool around 2 meters long
6. Glue one end of the wool to the top of the cardboard triangle
7. Wrap the wool around the cardboard, slowly going down, until the entire cardboard is wrapt in green wool
8. glue cotton balls onto the card in the spots you would like
9. Use the stickers to decorate your card even more
10. Use the alphabet stickers to write a message sush as 'happy holidays' onto the card
11. Use the alphabet stickers to write your name onto the card
12. Give the card to someone you like

4. Think about shapes and colours
