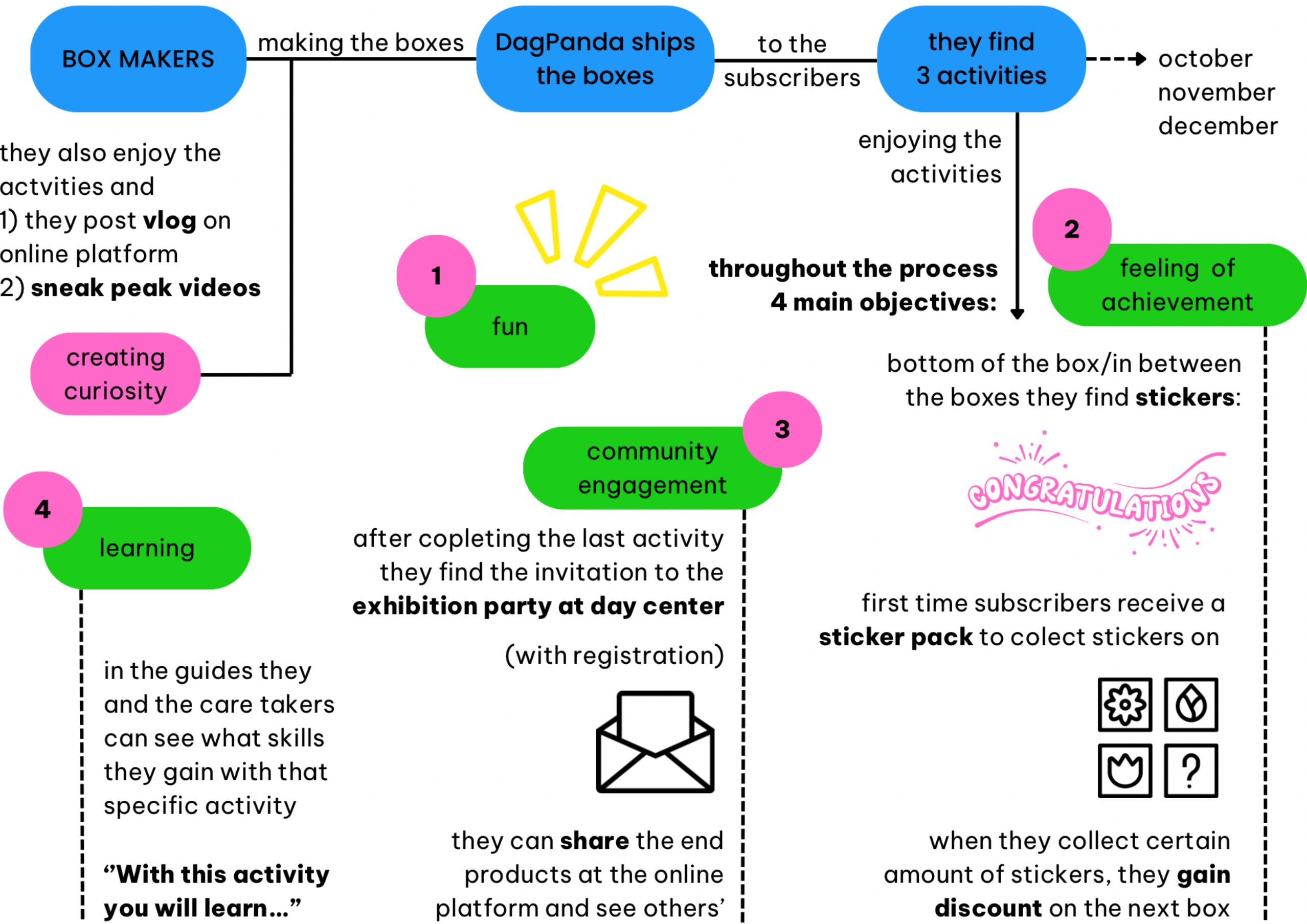


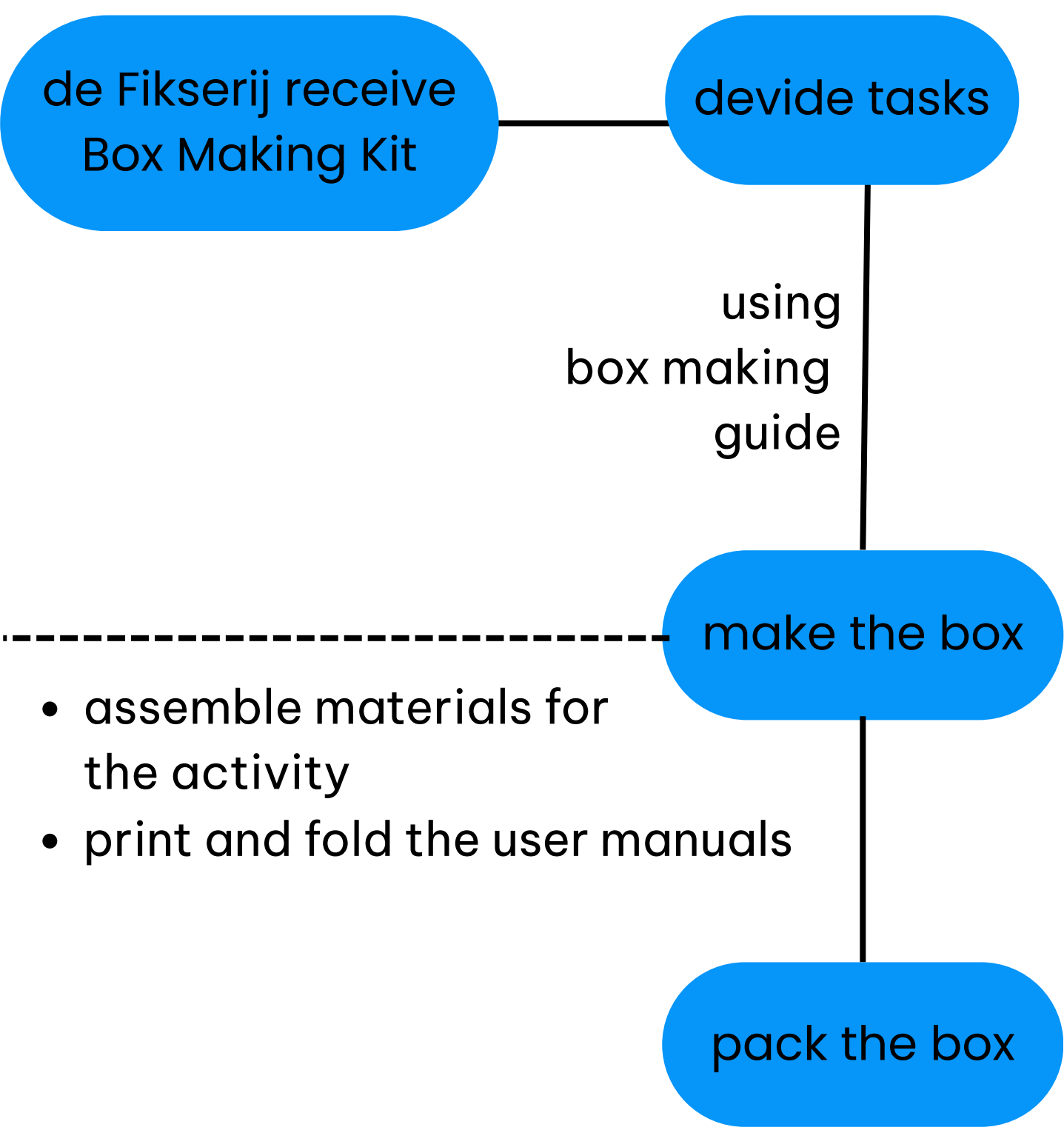
Challenge

1 October

Make your own Halloween cape!

1. Build fine motoric & basic sewing skills through guided stitching and fabric handling.
2. Encourage self-expression by designing and choosing how the cape looks.

2 November

1. Practice zine-making through folding, drawing, and pasting.
2. Build confidence by sharing a story or memory.
3. Stimulate imagination and storytelling using leaves or nature themes.

3 December

Make a Christmas gift box!

1. Develop hand-eye coordination and sequencing skills by folding and assembling the box.
2. Foster empathy and social thinking by choosing or making a gift for someone else.
